

## REPORT FROM THE 1<sup>st</sup> LEARNING/TEACHING/TRAINING ACTIVITY ESTELLA-LIZARRA, 4<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER, 2021







The 1st learning / teaching / training event of the Erasmus+ (KA2) project **"STANDING FOR OUR RIGHTS"** was held from 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021 to 8<sup>th</sup> October 2021 in Estella-Lizarra, Spain.

The Italian delegation from the "IISS Palazzolo Acreide" arrived in Estella-Lizarra on October 3<sup>rd</sup> and departed on October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mrs. Santa Nigro, and Mrs. Ornella Valvo and the students Miss Dalila Cassia, Miss Claudia Maria Corradino, Mr.Francesco Lia, Mr.Paolo Nigro and Mr.Gabriele Scifo.

The Czech delegation from "Obchodní akademie s.r.o." in Karviná arrived in Estella-Lizarra on October 3<sup>rd</sup> and departed on October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mr. Martin Frolík, Mrs. Pavla Kubíčková and Mrs. Zdeňka Parchanská. and the students Miss Veronika Mrozková, Miss Anna Beranová, Mr. Ondřej Kruťa, Mr. Martin Sobek and Mr. Dominik Ročkár.

The organizer of the 1<sup>st</sup> learning/teaching/training activity was the Spanish school "Lizarra Ikastola" from Estella-Lizarra. The following team of students participated: Miss Nahia Martinez de Goñi, Miss Haizea Esparza, Miss Nahikari Unanua, Miss Jare Franco, Miss Joane Pelaez, Miss Uxue Tulebras, Miss Leire Gardoki, Miss Angela del Campo, Miss Leire de Antonio, Miss Nerea Sadaba. The teachers team consisted of Mr.Gaizka Untzueta Irasuegi, Mr. Cesar Etxeberria Saez, Miss Maialen Ros Iturgaitz, Miss Ohiana Zubikoa and the headmaster Mr. Joseba Tristán.

On Sunday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> all the participants were welcomed by the coordinator from the hosting school, Mr. Gaizka Untzueta and then transferred to the hotel and host families.

On Monday, October 4<sup>th</sup>, there was a common meeting with all delegations being welcomed by the headmaster of the Spanish school, Mr. Joseba Tristán. Then, a short cultural performance prepared by the Spanish students followed. Later, the participating schools presented their schools and their national cuisine to the others. After lunch, there was a meeting at the town hall where the participants met the mayor

of the town, Mr. Koldo Leoz. In the evening all teachers met again for a welcome dinner in the centre of the town.

On Tuesday, October 5<sup>th</sup> the program started with presentation of the school systems in the partner countries followed by presentations of results of surveys on human rights done by the partner schools. Then role-play activities on human rights and a group work on "What do human rights mean to me?" took place. In the afternoon the teachers and students took part in a guided tour in the town to learn about the host town.

On Wednesday, October 6<sup>th</sup> the morning program started with a seminar on "Basque Autonomy and minoritarian languages in Europe: when the small are big" presented by specialist Mr. Unai Arellano. Afterwards all the participants visited Pamplona/Iruñea with a stop in Gares (St. James Way) and Erreniaga to visit places connected with a human right movement.

On Thursday, October 7<sup>th</sup> the teachers and students went on an excursion to the Basque coast. It included a workshop in Albaola, the Sea Factory of the Basques, a Visit of the fishermen town of Pasai Donibane and a walk in San Sebastian/Donostia.

On Friday, October 8<sup>th</sup> the teachers and students met at school and attended a lesson according to their choice. A Compass/compassito game "A map of human rights" and a quiz game with Kahoot about Standing for Our Rights project followed. After lunch the students spend the afternoon with their host families and gathered again in the evening for farewell dinner and final ceremony at Nabarra Restaurant where all the students and teachers received their certificates of attendance. The program of the meeting was officially concluded.

On Saturday, October 9th both the foreign delegations left Estella-Lizarra.

During the 1<sup>st</sup> learning/teaching/training activity the teachers agreed on the following:

- The coordinators of the partner schools will meet at a video-conference in November to discuss local activities regarding the next project topic and to fix deadlines for outputs from those meetings.
- Each country will prepare a presentation of their country, town, and school to be presented during the 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility in Italy.
- Each country will prepare some national dishes that will be presented at a presentation of national cuisine during the 2<sup>nd</sup> mobility in Italy.
- All the partner schools will share the results of the 1<sup>st</sup> mobility with their colleagues and will publish information about the event on the school websites and facebook pages and instagram pages.
- The coordinator of the project will publish the outputs and photos from the 1<sup>st</sup> mobility on the project webpage and facebook page.
- The second mobility to Palazzolo Acreide, is planned for February 7<sup>th</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> (with travel dates 6<sup>th</sup> February, resp. 12<sup>th</sup> February), and the third mobility

to the Czech Republic is planned for April 4<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> (with travel dates 3<sup>rd</sup> April, resp. 9<sup>th</sup> April).

All the participants of the "Standing for our rights" project agree that the run of the meeting was very good and smooth, without any problems and they enjoy the participation in the project. All the participants find the cooperation very good and appreciate the work that has been done so far.
