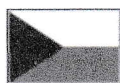




## REPORT FROM THE 2<sup>nd</sup> LEARNING/TEACHING/TRAINING ACTIVITY PALAZZOLO ACREIDE, 17<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> MARCH, 2022

The 2<sup>nd</sup> learning, teaching, training activity of the Erasmus+ (KA2) project “**STANDING FOR OUR RIGHTS**“ was held from 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to 21<sup>st</sup> March 2022 in Palazzolo Acreide, Italy.

The Spanish delegation from the “Lizarra Ikastola” arrived in Palazzolo Acreide on March 16<sup>th</sup> and departed on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022. The delegation was composed of the teachers Miss Maialen Ros Iturgaiz, and Miss Oihana Zubikoa Paniagua and the students Miss Leire De Antonio García, Miss Ángela Del Campo Azcona, Miss Leire Gardoqui Zubelzu, Miss Nerea Sadaba Cabero and Miss Uxue Tulebras García.

The Czech delegation from “Obchodní akademie s.r.o.” in Karviná arrived in Palazzolo Acreide on March 16<sup>th</sup> and departed on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mr. Martin Frolík, Mrs. Pavla Kubíčková and the students Mr. Filip Tyc, Mr. Milan Fekeč, Miss Anna Beranová, Miss Agáta Červinková and Miss Valerie Szebestová.

The organizer of the 3<sup>rd</sup> learning/teaching/training activity was the Italian school “IISS Palazzolo Acreide” from Palazzolo Acreide.

On Wednesday, March 16<sup>th</sup> all the participants were welcomed by the coordinator from the hosting school, Mrs. Tina Nigro and then transferred to the hotel and host families.

On Thursday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, there was a common meeting with all delegations at school. First, the participating schools presented their schools and their national cuisine to the others. Afterwards, the students played some Kahoot games prepared by other students from the participating school. Then the activity “Living library” followed. In the afternoon, there was a tour of the town where the participants visited the most interesting places in Palazzolo Acreide. In the evening all teachers and students met again for a welcome dinner.

by a short discussion on the topic of immigration. Later, all participants visited the Town Hall where they were welcomed by the deputy mayor for education, Mrs. Giovanna Scollo. After lunch, the programme continued with a visit to the Greek Theatre and the Bouleuterion.

On Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, the morning programme started with a seminar on "Women's rights" presented by Mrs. Masha Gallito followed by students' presentations on the topic. The afternoon the foreign students spent with their peers in Palazzolo Acreide while the teachers had an informal meeting to evaluate the activities of the meeting in Sicily and discuss plans for the next meeting in Karviná.

On Sunday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, the teachers and students went on an excursion to Noto and Marzamemi, cultural places near Palazzolo Acreide connected with the topic of human rights.

On Monday, March 21<sup>st</sup>, the teachers and students went for the second excursion to Siracusa and Ortigia and the meeting was concluded with a farewell dinner and final ceremony where all the students and teachers received their certificates of attendance.

On Tuesday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>, all the foreign delegations left Palazzolo Acreide and returned to their countries.

During the 2<sup>nd</sup> learning/teaching/training activity the teachers agreed on the following:


- Each country will make a powerpoint presentation of the results of surveys on "Children's rights". Each school will create their own questionnaire focused on the most important issues in their region and country.
- Each country will prepare a presentation of their country, town, and school to be presented during the meeting in the Czech Republic.
- Each country will prepare some national dishes that will be presented at a presentation of national cuisine during the meeting at the Czech school.
- All the partner schools will share the results of the 2<sup>nd</sup> learning teaching training activity with their colleagues and students and will publish information about the meeting in Sicily on the school website and facebook page.
- All the partner schools will check their budgets and will fill in their part in the Mobility Tool regarding the meeting in Sicily.
- The coordinator of the project will update the webpage and facebook page with presentations created by the students of the participating schools
- The school coordinators will check their list of local activities, during the meeting in Karviná they will evaluate the compliance of the list of activities in the application form with the activities done so far and will prepare the schedule of local activities for the last period of the project.


All the participants of the "Standing for our rights" project agree that the run of the meeting was very good and smooth, without any problems and they enjoy the


The 3<sup>rd</sup> project meeting is going to be held in Karviná at the beginning of April.




