

## REPORT FROM THE 3<sup>rd</sup> LEARNING/TEACHING/TRAINING ACTIVITY KARVINÁ, 4<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> APRIL, 2022







The 3<sup>rd</sup> learning, teaching, training activity of the Erasmus+ (KA2) project **"STANDING FOR OUR RIGHTS"** was held from 4<sup>th</sup> April 2022 to 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022 in Karviná, the Czech Republic.

The Spanish delegation from the "Lizarra Ikastola" arrived in Karviná on April 3<sup>rd</sup> and departed on April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mr. Gaizka Untzueta Irasuegi, and Miss Oihana Zubikoa Paniagua and the students Miss Nahia Martinez de Goñi, Miss Haizea Esparza, Miss Nahikari Unanua, Miss Jare Franco and Miss Joane Pelaez.

The Italian delegation from "IISS Palazzolo Acreide" in Palazzolo Acreide arrived in Karviná April 3<sup>rd</sup> and departed on April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The delegation was composed of the teachers Mrs. Santa Nigro and Mrs. Mariannina Tanasi and the students Miss Mariangela Leone, Miss Chiara Pantano, Miss Martina Altomare, Mr. Antonio Daquino and Mr. Giovanni Scibetta.

The organizer of the 3<sup>rd</sup> learning/teaching/training activity was the Czech school "Obchodní akademie s.r.o." from Karviná.

On Sunday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> all the participants were welcomed by the coordinator from the hosting school, Mr. Martin Frolík, the deputy headmistress Mrs.Pavla Kubíčková and the teacher Mrs.Zdeňka Parchanská and then transferred to the hotel and host families.

On Monday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, there was a welcome ceremony at the Regional library followed by watching a short film "Every minute of a life" which was focused on the main topic of the meeting – children's rights. After lunch there was a tour of the school. In the afternoon, the programme started with presentation of the Photovoice method followed by a photography workshop. Then the students from all participating schools showed their presentations on children's rights. In the afternoon, the participants visited the most interesting places in the centre of Karviná. In the evening all teachers met again for a welcome dinner in the Vanilla restaurant.

On Tuesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, the participants were welcomed by the deputy mayor, Mr. Bizoň at the chateau in Karviná. A guided tour of the chateau followed. Afterwards, the participants returned to school where they prepared their tables for "Day of national cuisine". In the afternoon, the students worked on their photos in the town for the final exhibition while the teachers walked in the city park and had an informal meeting.

On Wednesday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, the hosting school prepared a whole day excursion to the Beskydy mountains nearby, to Pustevny so that the participants could learn more about the region.

On Thursday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, one of the Czech students, Veronika Mrozková led a workshop on children's rights and the participants created project posters focused on this topic. Later, a lecture and a discussion with a lawyer from the Ombudsman's office took place. After lunch, the students discussed their project posters and then went for an excursion to Archeopark near Karviná.

On Friday, April 8th, the teachers and students met again at the Regional library where the exhibition of photos taken during the project meeting was officially open. The exhibition will last for two weeks. Afterwards, the students played some games prepared by librarians and learned more about how the system of borrowing books works. After lunch, the teachers from all participating countries had a meeting to evaluate the run of the project and the activities that have been done so far and the meeting was concluded with a farewell dinner and final ceremony where all the students and teachers received their certificates of attendance.

On Saturday, April 9th, all the foreign delegations left Karviná.

During the 3<sup>rd</sup> learning/teaching/training activity the teachers agreed on the following:

- Each country will check if all planned activities for the whole project were done.
- Each country will organize a "Living library" event and the "Photovoice" activity with an exhibition.
- Each country will organize excursions to places connected with human rights movement.
- All the partner schools will share the results of the 3<sup>rd</sup> learning teaching training activity with their colleagues and students and will publish information about the meeting in Karviná on the school websites and facebook pages.
- All the partner schools will check their budgets and will fill in their part in the Mobility Tool regarding the meeting in Karviná.
- The coordinator of the project will update the webpage and facebook page with presentations created by the students from all the participating schools

All the participants of the "Standing for our rights" project agree that the run of the meeting was very good and smooth, without any problems and they enjoyed the participation in the project. All the participants find the cooperation very good and appreciate the work that has been done so far.

The project will continue with local activities and online meetings and the project period ends on August 31st, 2022.
